The website brings together everything you need to start planning your participation in this very special European event.

A remarkable venue in Madrid

The congress will take place at the **Ilustre Colegio Oficial de Médicos de Madrid (ICOMEM)**, located at **Calle Santa Isabel, 51, 28012 Madrid**.

This is a highly accessible and central location, with excellent public transport connections and easy access from Atocha.

ICOMEM is a historic building with great institutional and architectural value, which gives the congress a special and distinguished setting. Its location places participants right in the heart of Madrid's cultural axis, surrounded by some of the city's most iconic places.

Nearby highlights include the Museo Reina Sofía, the Prado Museum, the Royal Botanic Garden, El Retiro Park, and several other landmarks that make the area one of the most attractive and walkable parts of the city. The venue is also well connected by metro, with nearby stations such as Antón Martín, Estación del Arte, Lavapiés, and Atocha, as well as direct access via Atocha-Cercanías and with nearby hotels and restaurants.

Key dates

The abstract submission period will start on 6 July 2026 and close on 1 November 2026. Please note that at least one author must be registered for the congress in order for a submission to be considered.

Registration fees

The congress offers different registration categories to make participation accessible to a wide range of attendees: families, students, professionals, and professionals from low-income countries.

* The student fee applies exclusively to undergraduate university students. A valid certificate of enrolment must be uploaded during registration. All supporting documentation will be subject to verification within 45 days.

All registration fees include three coffee breaks during the congress and lunch on the first day. It also includes technological support for translation into the language of your choice

Pre-conference and welcome cocktail

The pre-conference has an additional cost of €65 per person and will consist of 6 parallel workshops organised in three time slots, with 2 workshops running in parallel in each slot. Each participant will be able to choose 3 workshops in total.
